HOW TO SIGN UP FOR A JOHN BEAD OUTLET CLASS

The John Bead Outlet class schedule will be managed by email and phone.

Registration at this time will be via phone and confirmation of class sign-ups will be via email.

Please tell us which class you would like to register for and leave your name and phone number.

If the minimum number of students does not register at least 3 days prior to the date posted, the class will be cancelled via email. A John Bead representative will make every effort to contact you if a class needs to be cancelled for any reason. You are always welcome to call to confirm that your class is being held if you have any doubts.

Class Fees: Currently, all our classes are \$25. Students must bring or purchase the supplies needed as listed in each class description. Supplies Students Must Bring (as listed in each class description) are in addition to the class fee.

Supplies: Students will be told in advance what products or tools they need to bring with them. They can purchase anything they need as well as pay for their class before entering the classroom. We recommend arriving at least 30 minutes prior to your class to shop. Unpaid merchandise may not go into the classroom.

Bonus: Students will be given 15% off all regularly priced merchandise (not on the workshop fee) on the day of the class.

CLASS POLICIES FOR STUDENTS

We ask that any brand specific materials be purchased from the Outlet and that you do not substitute. For example; if the teacher requires you to bring a "Tropical Punch" flower maker there is no other substitute for this component.

Only registered students may sit in the classroom. As such, children or guardians (depending on the class) may not sit in the classroom unless they have paid for a full registration.

Class handouts are for students who attend the class. Registrants who do not attend the class will not receive class handouts and copies are a violation of copyright law.

Prerequisite Skills: All students are assumed to have the prerequisite skills listed in all class descriptions. If you sign up for a class and you do not have the prerequisites outlined, you do so at your own risk and will probably be unable to complete the project. Teachers must work at the pace as outlined in their original class descriptions.

If the class is several hours and a lunch or coffee break is included, snack items and beverages must be consumed in the class and not anywhere in the store. No microwaving.

Double Long Necklace

Class Description: Create a stunning long necklace with crystals and pearls with a focal stone pendant.

- * Set pattern
- * String on beads & crystals
- * Create a simple loop to add the focal bead

Level: All levels, suitable for beginners

Prerequisites: None

Class Time: Two Hours

Techniques: Basic stringing, Beading, Patterns, Simple Loops

Tools and Supplies Provided In The Class:

Round nose pliers, Flat nose pliers Head Pins, Jump Rings, Lobster Clasp

Supplies Students Must Bring or Purchase for Class:

- 1 roll Beading wire (49 strand)
- 1 pack Crimping Tubes
- Glass pearls (4 strands in 2 colours)
- Crystals (1 stand)
- 1 Focal stone (on a bail)
- Approximately \$15-\$20



JBO Class 002
Stacking Bracelets

With instructor Laurie Poirier

Class Description: Set of three semi-precious stone stretch bracelets

Level: All levels, suitable for beginners

Prerequisites: None

Class Time: 1 - 1 ½ Hours

Techniques: Stringing, knots and sizing of bracelets

Tools and Supplies Provided in The Class:

Elastic, E6000 Glue, Scissors, bracelet sizing board or ruler

Supplies Students Must Bring or Purchase for Class:

- 3 different strands of semi-precious round stones 8-10mm
- 1 pack Silver tone spacer beads
- Approximately \$15-\$20

Semi-Precious Stone Bracelets

Class Description: Create your own bracelet using semi-precious stone chips and silver or gold tone beads.

1 pack Beads (mixed Czech glass beads at front of store)

Love Knots Chainmaille

With instructor Laurie Poirier

Class Description: Chainmaille Bracelet with a 2-2 weave and a Mobius ring flower in the center.

Level: All levels, suitable for beginners

Prerequisites: None

Class Time: 2 hours

Techniques:

- Learn two Chainmaille weaves, 2x2 chain and Mobius Knots
- Learn to open and close jump rings properly
- Learn to hold your tools ergonomically to avoid stress on your hands
- Opening and closing jump rings, attaching clasps

Tools and Supplies Provided in The Class:

2 Pair of toothless pliers, bead matt

Supplies Students Must Bring or Purchase for Class:

1 set Toggle Clasps
1 package 11/64" 18g Copper Jump rings

Tools and Supplies Provided in The Class:

wire cutter, pliers, shape for circle, one round shell focal

Supplies Students Must Bring or Purchase For Class:

12 gauge Silver Aluminum Wire

26 gauge Silver Wire

Wire wrapping wire (gold, silver or copper)

1 strand semi-precious chips

Approximately \$15 - \$20 with many supplies left over to make more trees.



JBO Class 013 Fabulous Focals

Class Description: Learn about wire gauge and different wire wrapping techniques to create focal pendants. You'll explore different finishing techniques to create a completed necklace. JBO Class 014 Simple Stringing

Class Description: Design and create necklaces and bracelets with basic bead stringing and finishing techniques. Learn the proper techniques for attaching clasps and crimping.

Level: All levels, suitable for beginners

Prerequisites: None

Class Time: 2 hours

Techniques: Stringing, crimping

Tools and Supplies Provided in The Class:
Pliers, Wire Cutter, one set of clasps

Supplies Students Must Bring or Purchase for Class:

2 sets of toggle clasps (instructor will show you which work best in class)

1 strand of semi-precious beads (ideally an oval shape medium to small)

1 strand small beads to use as spacers (coffee bean shape)

1 package glass beads 4mm for accent

1 pack crimp tubes #2

1 roll Econoflex FINE craft and beading wire

Basic Wire Crochet

With instructor Melanie Ferguson

Class Description: Learn to crochet with wire to create bangle-style bracelets. Students will learn how to do the single crochet stitch with yarn for practice. You will plan the project and arrange the beads according to the pattern. You will learn how to finish the bracelet with tied ends.

Level: All levels, suitable for beginners

Prerequisites: Basic crochet skills an asset but not required

Class Time: 2 hours

Techniques: Single crochet stitch; bead stringing

Scissors

Non-Tarnish silver-plated 24Gauge wire (craft wire)

One strand of 16-inch semi-precious chips

Crochet hook (2.5, or 3.0, or even 3.5)
